Kirk Stoner, Cumberland County Planning Commission, introduced Elizabeth Grant. She will be our representative from County.

Mr. Stoner discussed several areas that the County will be giving aid to our township.

Parks grant program—Parks, trails and greenways –50% match.

Flood insurance rate maps.

MPC reviews.

Route 81 widening at exit 44 and 52.

The Memorandum of Understanding is offered through County. Mr. Stoner recommended that Penn Township join this program.

Amendment 303A.3 was advertised, adopted and added to our Stormwater Management Ordinance.

Sink Hole at Key Logistice. They have e-mailed the township their plan concerning the repairs.

Mr. Hurst's problems with water run-off on his property have been addressed and should be solved in the near future. The warehouse requests an easement from Mr. Hurst.

Penn Township should add to the Developers Agreement that testing of water on a monthly basis will be required. Checking for gas, oil, antifreeze and any other foreign matter is imperative.


Bill Seaton will be at our April meeting to discuss reports that were received on the water tests.
