

ORDINANCE 2013- 08

**AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING THE PER CAPITA TAX ORDINANCE AND
ABOLISHING THE PENN TOWNSHIP PER CAPITA TAX**

WHEREAS, the Penn Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania enacted an Resolution on March 23, 1963, being Resolution 3-23-63, which authorized the collection of a per capita tax, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Penn Township have determined that the collection of the per capita tax is no longer in the best interest of the citizens of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Penn Township have decided to repeal the per capita tax ordinance at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby adopted by the Supervisors of Penn Township that:

Section 1. Short Title: This Ordinance shall be known as the “Penn Township Per Capita Tax Repeal Ordinance.”

Section 2. Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to repeal the Penn Township Per Capita Tax, and to abolish the tax.

Section 3. Preamble: The preamble recited above is hereby incorporated by reference herein.

Section 4. Repeal of Per Capita Tax Ordinance: The Resolution 3-23-63 which enacted the collection of a Per Capita Tax in Penn Township is hereby REPEALED.


Section 5. Administrative Provisions: The Supervisors of Penn Township may, by resolution, enact provisions necessary for the administration of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Severability: If any section, sub-section, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.


